Assembly of First Nations National 2SLGBTQQA+ Council – Yukon Representative Nomination Form

The Assembly of First Nations National 2SLGBTQQA+ Council (“2SLGBTQQA+ Council”) represents First Nations 2SLGBTQQA+ persons across the country and brings awareness to issues that impact them.

This policy sets out the process for nominating and selecting a Yukon Representative (“Yukon Representative”) for the 2SLGBTQQA+ Council.

Roles and Responsibilities

The roles and responsibilities of the 2SLGBTQQA+ Council members include, but are not limited to:

- Raising awareness of 2SLGBTQQA+ issues and advocating on behalf of First Nations 2SLGBTQQA+ in the Yukon and across Canada;
- Attending, preparing for and participating in National 2SLGBTQQA+ Council meetings and reporting back to the AFN Yukon Region and Regional Chief;
- Establishing partnerships and relationships with 2SLGBTQQA+ Council members in the Yukon Region and from other regions;
- Reporting to the Regional Office on their work as well as the broader activities and initiatives of the National 2SLGBTQQA+ Council;
- Developing working relationships with other First Nation and Indigenous 2SLGBTQQA+ organizations regionally and nationally; and
- Leading or supporting the work of any of the portfolios listed under the various National 2SLGBTQQA+ Council sub-committees.

Term

The term of each Yukon Representative on the 2SLGBTQQA+ Council is three years starting from the date of appointment. A Yukon Representative can serve for a maximum of two terms.

Eligibility Criteria

Yukon representatives on the 2SLGBTQQA+ Council must be:

- 19 years of age or older;
- self-identifying as 2SLGBTQQA+;
- a citizen, member or beneficiary of a Yukon First Nation;
- able to demonstrate the capacity/motivation necessary to participate in 2SLGBTQQA+ Council work;
- of good character, credibility and reputation;
- committed to adhering to the roles and responsibilities of a 2SLGBTQQA+ Council representative as set out in the 2SLGBTQQA+ Council Terms of Reference; and
- able to produce a satisfactory vulnerable sector check.



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Nomination Process

Your Nomination Package should include:

- 1) Completed Nomination Form
- 2) Resumé
- 3) A copy or scan of two written letters of reference
- 4) A copy or scan of a valid Vulnerable Sector Check (if you do not currently have a valid Vulnerable Sector check, you will be expected to obtain and provide one upon appointment to the AFN National 2SLGBTQQIA+ Council.)
