First reading of Bill-C61 on December 11, 2023:

On Dec 11, 2023, Minister of Indigenous Services, Patty Hajdu, moved to introduce into First Reading, Bill C-61, An Act respecting water, source water, drinking water, wastewater and related infrastructure on First Nation lands (short title First Nations Clean Water Act).
